

He was as delighted as the others with his cure but being generous and though ul for others, he felt it his duty to return and thank the man who had done him this miraculous good turn. We all need to be more grateful to God every day of our lives—more grateful than we have been. He has not only given us life on this earth with its joys and its sorrows, but He has prepared for us a future life where there will be no admixture of sorrows. It is for that life that we are working. It is because there is a heaven a er death that we are Chris ans. He is assis ng us daily to get there.
