St. Valentine's Feast Day—February 14


Patron Saint of: love, marriages, engagements, young people, greetings, travelers, bee keepers, people with epilepsy and various churches

This famous saint, an Italian doctor who later became a priest, inspired the creation of the holiday of Valentine's Day. He was sent to jail for performing weddings for couples during a time when new marriages were outlawed in the ancient Rome.
